



State Commission on Judicial Conduct Selected Fiscal and Policy Issues - Senate

1. **Formal Proceedings and Appeals:** Recommendations delete Rider 2, Formal Proceedings and Appeals, that requires \$21,375 each year to be used for formal proceedings and appeals expenses. The rider permits the agency to carry forward any unexpended balances into the second year and allows those appropriations to be used for any purpose. As shown below, annual expenses for formal proceedings and appeals vary significantly with amounts for most years significantly below \$21,375. As a result, the agency often carries forward a majority of the designated funding for use in the second year of the biennium to meet agency operational costs and ends up lapsing funds in the second year that cannot be spent on the designated purposes.

Elimination of this rider permits the agency to expend funds previously designated for formal proceedings and appeals for any purpose. The agency has reported its intent to continue prioritizing all necessary formal proceedings and appeals expenditures (See also, Rider Highlights – Senate #2).

2. **Investigator Travel:** Recommendations delete Rider 3, Investigator Travel, that requires \$5,000 each year to be used for investigator travel to investigate possible causes of judicial misconduct. Elimination of this rider permits the agency to expend funds previously designated for investigator travel for any purpose. The agency has reported its intent to continue prioritizing all necessary travel expenditures for the original intended purpose (See also, Rider Highlights – Senate #3).
