



Board of Chiropractic Examiners Selected Fiscal and Policy Issues - Senate

1. **Update on Exceptional Items Funded in the 88th Regular Session.** Recommendations maintain \$320,000 in General Revenue funding associated with adopted Exceptional Item Requests of the 88th Regular Session. The agency received funding to fill 2.5 vacant FTE positions: a part-time Chiropractic Director; a full-time Compliance Assistant; and a full-time Licensing Assistant. These positions have all been filled. The agency reported that the additional staff have helped reduce heavy workloads on other staff, which has improved morale. The Chiropractic Director is a licensed chiropractor who handles scope of practice questions and standard of care cases, which helped reduce the workload of the agency's General Counsel. The Compliance Assistant handles administrative tasks for both the legal and compliance teams, which allows those teams to focus more on investigations. The Licensing Assistant assists the Director of Licensure with license applications and renewals. Prior to that employee's tenure, the Director of Licensure was handling all applications and renewals for the entire state.
